



London, England / Day 1

Begin your journey in historic and cosmopolitan London. Meet fellow guests, your expert trip leaders and dedicated guest services staff for a festive welcome dinner at the hotel. We depart the next day for the Azores. *Rosewood London*

Azores, Portugal / Days 2 – 3

The Azores are often called Europe's best-kept secret. Enjoy a scenic hike at Lagoa do Fogo, a crater lake surrounded by lush greenery. Discover the thermal pools at Terra Nostra Park and enjoy panoramic views at Sete Cidades, a caldera home to two vibrant lakes. Seek out whales and dolphins in the waters surrounding São Miguel Island, home to many species of cetaceans. *Azor Hotel*

Essaouira, Morocco / Days 4 – 5

Past and present intertwine to make Essaouira a unique seaside retreat. Explore the colorful souks in the medina, delve into the city's fascinating Jewish history and walk along the ramparts facing the Atlantic Ocean to the port, where fishermen set out into the waters on traditional cobalt-blue boats. *Heure Bleue Palais*

Tenerife, Canary Islands, Spain / Days 6 – 8

Our base in Tenerife is the perfect spot to launch an exploration of the island's natural beauty, from the snow-capped volcanic peak that dominates the landscape to a sailing excursion around the coastline. Head out to La Gomera Island, one of the lesser-visited spots in the Canaries, or choose to simply relax at the luxurious seaside resort.

The Ritz-Carlton, Abama

Accra, Ghana / Days 9 – 12

Accra's vibrant spirit permeates its lively markets, art galleries and monuments. Meet with Ga craftsmen who fashion custom-made coffins inspired by their traditional burial practices. Take a day trip to northern Togo and visit remote villages, where an ancient way of life still persists. *Kempinski Hotel Gold Coast City Accra*

Cape Verde / Day 12

Cape Verde is a beautiful archipelago off the coast of West Africa. Trek through the lava fields at Monte Leste and see the salt pans in the crater of a now-extinct volcano, Pedra de Lume. Visit the spectacular Buracona Lagoon, known as the "blue eye". Cruise the waters by catamaran and soak up the enchanting scenery along the coast. *Hilton Cabo Verde Sal Resort*

Fernando de Noronha, Brazil / Days 13 – 15

Fernando de Noronha is an under-the-radar paradise filled with dramatic landscapes and idyllic beaches. Whether you're diving, snorkeling or embarking on a boat tour of the island, you will have the chance to experience its unspoiled beauty and incredible marine life. Explore the island's historic forts and enjoy a festive dinner on the beach. *Pousada Ze Maria*

Rio de Janeiro, Brazil / Days 16 – 18

Take in panoramic views of the city from one of Rio's most famous landmarks, Corcovado Mountain with its 100-foot-tall Christ the Redeemer statue. Opt to ride a cable car to Sugar Loaf Mountain, visit the botanical garden, or learn a few new dance moves at Samba City, where participants prepare for Carnival. *Belmond Copacabana Palace*
